Meeting was called to order. Chairman went over status of Welcome to Eliot Sign project and reported to the Committee.

Russ McMullen made a motion that the Business Development Committee procure one "Welcome to Eliot" sign (due to a lack of funding to complete both signs at this time), and that said sign is placed on the Kittery side of Eliot. Seconded by Craig Goss and passed by unanimous consent.

Craig Goss made a motion that the Business Development Committee spend up to \$2,500 for the first "Welcome to Eliot" sign, said amount to be delivered to the sign maker as a deposit. The sign will have the following options:

- Blue background color

- Town Seal – hand painted

- Reduce the overall height by 12" – provide a system to display temporary signs under the "Welcome to Eliot" sign

- Sign posts to be installed in Portland cement concrete

- Town DPW assistance to install the sign shall be obtained in writing

Seconded by Russ McMullen and passed by unanimous consent.

The next meeting is set for next Wednesday at 5 pm in Town Hall. The regular July meeting will be cancelled, and the Committee will meet in August (time and date TBD).
