In a letter dated December 6, 2013, the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Air Resources Division (DES) requested additional information in support of the Title V Operating Permit renewal application for the Public Service of New Hampshire (PSNH) Schiller Station facility located in Portsmouth, New Hampshire. PSNH initially responded on December 20, 2013 and subsequently worked with DES staff to supplement and amend that initial response.

With the initial response filed on December 20, 2013 and amendments/supporting documentation filed on January 13 and March 3, 2014, DES hereby acknowledges that PSNH has fully complied with DES's December 6, 2013 request. DES will consider this additional information in its final decision regarding the Title V Operating Permit renewal application. In accordance with New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Env-A 622.08(d), *Decisions*, DES is required to issue a decision within 30 working days of receiving the additional information. Therefore, DES intends to issue a final decision by April 14, 2014.
