
Meeting minutes for January 20, 2015

Guest –

- 1) Reviewed and approved minutes for meeting held on December 16, 2014
- 2) Transfer station, Pay-to-throw, Kitchen food waste collection program
  - A) Transfer station
    - The redemption center previously used by the town is no longer in operation – looking for a new redemption center
    - The selectmen continue to look at the possibility of partnering with Kittery for collection of Household Hazardous Waste
    - The Police Auxiliary may help with traffic control at the transfer station
  - B) Kitchen food waste collection
    - The town now is stocking smaller bags for the Kitchen Food Waste collection program. The use of smaller bags may help to reduce cost.
- 3) SWRC action items:
  - No new action items were added.
- 4) Committee action items for 2015
  - The changes to the Waste Recycling and Disposal Ordinance proposed by the SWRC were provided to the Town Manager and Planning Assistant. The changes will be reviewed and provided to the selectmen.  
The changes will need to be presented at town meeting for approval.
- 5) Rye, NH – the Rye, NH Recycling Education Committee is proposing to implement PAYT. Jim attended a recent meeting to provide some history of the Eliot process.
- 6) Maine Townsman – Jim provided a copy of the Maine Townsman November, 2014 issue which included an article about Eliot's PAYT program.
