Meeting opened 4:19PM by Vice Chair Jack McDonough. Switch for camera is broken so no video today (Dana will get new switch)

Joel advised that the letter to the four non-compliant private sewer systems (Sawgrass Meadows, Hidden Meadows, Blueberry and Pickering) has not been drafted yet. It has yet to be decided if the letters of non-compliance will go to the homeowners' associations themselves or to the individual homeowners within these developments. It was a consensus that letters should go to both the associations and to the individual homeowners. Joel will work with Dana on drafting the letters.

It was mentioned that Riverview Estates (off Old Road) has its own overboard discharge system and that it has been discovered that there is some intermingling between the untreated sewage and the storm-water system. There will be substantial CCTV work done in the spring to determine the scope and extent of the problem. All the appropriate agencies and Joel are aware of and following the issues. Any needed repairs will have to be paid by Riverview Estates.

Joel will be meeting with Cole Melindy of Underwood Associates on April 1st to review the O & M Manual.

Residents in the area of Pump Station 2 (Main Street and Kings Highway) are being consulted on upcoming plans and will be asked for input; and there may be neighborhood meetings set up to discuss individual homeowner concerns.

Joel will be asking the BOS to permit some further I & I work in the spring- when the water table is the highest.

Jack McDonough won't be here for either of the April meetings.
