Meeting minutes for Apr. 1, 2014

(Phil Lytle attending Budget Committee meeting)

- 1) Discuss Pros / Cons of selling Pay-to-throw bags at transfer station – Joel presented list of many reasons why he felt we should continue practice of not selling bags at transfer station.
It was agreed that if bags were sold at the transfer station, it would be a “no cash” transaction – only checks or credit/debit cards would be accepted.
After a discussion of how bag sales at the transfer station could be implemented, it was agreed to recommend not selling bags at the transfer station.
- 2) Discuss locations for bag sales – it was agreed that the current 2 locations were not sufficient. For the convenience of the residents, at least 2 more locations should be added. Joel provided a list of potential new locations that he will pursue.
- 3) Discuss possibility of managing Pay-to-throw program in house and decide on recommendations to present to selectmen – it was decided to review these topics after Joel talks to Waste Zero about long term options that are available and we meet again.
- 4) Next meeting – Next meeting scheduled for Apr. 15, 2014 at 6:30 pm at town garage.
