

Comp Plan Review Committee meeting August 6, 2015

Meeting opened 4:15 PM, no camera activation

Minutes of meeting of July 9nd, 2015 accepted with no changes.

Vickie had asked Kim to attend so Kim could give us an update on the progress of the Conservation Commission in the pursuit of its efforts as identified by the Comprehensive Plan. Kim advised she had already furnished Dana with her hard copy report but it appears we have never seen it. She will forward a copy to Dana for him to furnish to Melissa to put in our wire basket.

Some of Kim's efforts involved access to town land. While Punkintown residents do not object to our use of town land, they do not want us accessing it via (our end of) Punkintown Road (which road is private and not an accepted town road). Kim will explore accessing our land through the other end of Punkintown Road in South Berwick. We can already access York Pond from Rte 91 in York. Kim was also to have come back to us with information from Kate on the actual process for the various committees to register their input into any new applications/projects.

The Conservation Commission is also involved with public outreach, their open space plan (only the developer of the 38 units on Frost Hill Road has taken advantage of this to date), and helping people understand conservation easements.

We will get more details when the written report is received.

There was discussion of whether or not the Sewer Committee has been asked to produce, or has produced, a report on its activities. It was not established if the Sewer Committee has any obligations under the Comprehensive Plan. Vickie will ask Dana about this.
