


Sewer Committee meeting September 16, 2015



Present: Dick Dionne, Jack McDonough, Mike Dupuis, Nancy Shapleigh, Grant Hirst

Absent: Rich Russell, Steve Beckert

Others present: Jack Murphy, Joel Moulton, Justin LaFrance, Lee Bogh, Ron Rappucci, the latter three all residents of Blueberry Lane.

Meeting opened 4:15 PM. Camera was activated. Minutes of meeting of September 2nd were approved with minor corrections and a copy left for Wendy.

The Blueberry Lane issue was not on the agenda but Mike allowed residents to make a presentation and to discuss their thoughts. Justin LaFrance read a one-page statement (incorporated into the minutes by reference) outlining their concerns with the ownership issues and history surrounding the Blueberry Lane sewer system.

Justin has filed an FOA request with Dana and Dana is working on a response.

It was decided that the next Sewer Committee meeting on October 7, 2015 would be a workshop on the matter of Blueberry Lane, to which the three attendees from that street were invited to be present.

It is Nancy's recollection that (Tom?) Brown installed the sewer main from Greenwood at Blueberry up to Main Street. It is her recollection that Bill Cullen built the houses on Blueberry, plus a few on Greenwood.

Joel and Mike again stressed that when the town accepts a street, it is only for the street and the drainage and not for any utilities associated with the street.

Joel said he favored the development of a "Plan C" for sewer repairs/upgrades as he believes there is a good chance the question on the November ballot (where sewer users pay 100%) will fail.

There was agreement that for the next meeting all of us will develop questions we have regarding the possibility of establishing a sewer district. Those questions will be collected, discussed and submitted for answers. Mike/Joel will speak with Dana regarding getting John True from the State (or others from elsewhere?) down to talk with us about the attributes of a sewer district. None of us know enough about the pro's and con's to be able to render an opinion.

Mike will plan to devote the October 21st meeting to a workshop on the concept of a sewer district.
