
Meeting minutes for November 18, 2014

Guest –

- 1) Approved minutes for meetings held on October 21, 2014
- 2) Transfer station, Pay-to-throw, Kitchen food waste collection program
  - A) Transfer station
    - Recently had a Maine Municipal Association inspection. The results have not yet been provided to the town.
    - Gasoline was found in the waste oil collection tank which may require additional expense to resolve.
  - B) Kitchen food waste - changed to 96 gallon totes for kitchen food waste collection program is going well.
- 3) SWRC action items:
  - Update town ordinance(s) – review of the first four pages of the Waste Recycling and Disposal Ordinance is complete. The committee further discussed the remaining three pages. Household hazardous waste and kitchen food waste need to be defined along with a few other changes. The committee still plans to get the revised ordinance to the Town Manager by the end of the year.
- 4) Other – Joel discussed the household hazardous waste collection that was conducted on Nov. 8, 2014. He contracted with a new company, Environmental Products. Inc. (EPI) and was very satisfied with their performance. Total cost was \$6800.
