



Sewer Committee meeting April 20, 2016

Present: Mike Dupuis, Rich Dionne, Rich Russell, Steve Beckert, Grant Hirst, Nancy Shapleigh. Excused: Jack McDonough

Others: Joel Moulton, Jack Murphy, and Blair Hodge representing Village at Great Brook.

Meeting opened 4:16PM.

Blair was here to seek support from the Committee for sewer capacity of 10,800 GPD for his planned 88-90 unit development at 379 Bolt Hill Road. This project will be built in phases over 4-5 years. He realizes that there will be a charge for unused capacity after 180 days, and that charge has yet to be calculated.

Motion to recommend this allocation to the BOS was made, seconded and passed unanimously.

Motion was made and seconded and voted unanimously to recommend to the BOS an approval for 120 GPD for #20 Hillside Ave., the septic system for which property has failed.

Motion was made and seconded and voted unanimously to recommend to the BOS that they grant 4500 GPD to Eliot Commons Elderly Housing. It is noted that this 4500 GPD is a reallocation of a previously granted allocation for the proposed hotel. That reallocation leaves approximately 186 GPD remaining of the original allocation which had been granted for the hotel.

The total recommended to be granted at today's meeting is 15,420 GPD. This leaves 4,580 GPD capacity available of our original 200,000 capacity which we purchased from Kittery.

It is felt there is no need at this time to secure more capacity from Kittery than our original 200,000 GPD. Joel advises that he believes that we could gain between 15,000 and 20,000 GPD by repairing those defects which are responsible

for the remaining I & I, and he will be working on this all summer with completion planned for the fall.
