The following terms are defined in section 1-2 as meaning:
Setback: The minimum horizontal distance from the line to the nearest part of a structure
Accessory Structure: A structure which is incidental and subordinate to the principal structure

Frontage: The horizontal distance between the intersection of the side lot lines with the front lot line that abuts a town way or a private way meeting the minimum standards of a town street.

Building Height: The vertical distance between the highest point of the roof and the average grade of the ground adjoining the building
