

NOTICE OF BALLOT QUESTION ON WHETHER TO ABOLISH THE POSITION OF ELECTED COUNTY TREASURER

County of York, Maine

At an election to be held in York County, Maine on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, the following question will be submitted to a vote of the people:

Shall the position of elected county treasurer be abolished and replaced with a treasurer appointed by the county commissioners?

A **“YES”** vote will abolish the position of elected county treasurer for the County of York. Upon abolishment of the position of elected county treasurer, the county commissioners shall appoint a county treasurer in accordance with Title 30-A, Section 156(4) of the Maine Revised Statutes. A “yes” vote does not prevent a voter from voting for a candidate for the position of elected county treasurer. In the event the voters do not vote to abolish the position of elected county treasurer, the candidate receiving the most votes shall be the elected county treasurer.

A **“NO”** vote will result in a continuation of the existing electing county treasurer position. The candidate receiving the most votes shall be the elected county treasurer.
