Dear Neighbor,

As part of our everyday effort to deliver reliable energy to our customers and communities, we are preparing to perform maintenance on existing wood transmission structures. This work is a continuation of maintenance work within the powerline corridor near your property. This project is one of several that are designed to improve the reliability of the electric system serving New Hampshire.

We're Always Working to Serve You Better

Last year you received a postcard from Eversource regarding maintenance work taking place on or near your property within the powerline corridor via helicopter and ground crews. The helicopter work has been completed and now the remaining work necessary to complete the line maintenance project will begin taking place in your neighborhood in the coming weeks. We'll be working on the power line corridor that extends from Gosling Road in Newington, NH to Stacy Lane in Eliot, ME.

What You Can Expect

Since your property is on or near the power line corridor, here is important information about how we will work in your neighborhood:

- **Reliable Service:** Be assured that this work will not interrupt electric service to your property.
- **Proper Identification:** All people working on this project carry identification. Eversource contractors will occasionally be in your neighborhood to tell you what to expect with the nearby construction project. They may leave an informational doorhanger at your home or knock on your door to talk to you about the project work. We're letting you know about this outreach in advance so you can be confident that the outreach is being conducted by a legitimate Eversource representative and is not a scam.
- **Where We'll Be Working:**
 - Newington: Gosling Road
 - Eliot: Pleasant Street, Route 103, Leach Road, State Road, Bolt Hill Road, Beech Road, Bradstreet Lane, Depot Road, Cedar Road, Stacy Lane
- **Communication:** Keeping the lines of communication open is important to us. Before work starts, our field outreach representatives may be in touch, either in person or with a door hanger notice to provide more details about the construction schedule for your area. We will also provide updates to keep you informed of our work. - **Construction Days:** Construction will be Monday through Friday, and Saturdays as necessary. Please keep in mind that the schedule may change due to weather and other unexpected circumstances.
- **Construction Activities:**
 - IN THE COMING WEEKS: Crews will inspect and install ground rings around the base of the existing wood structures.
 - OVERALL, you can expect:
 - There will be construction vehicles on the power line corridor, though we will make every effort to minimize any impact to your property.

- In wetland areas, we may temporarily install mats, which are flat surfaces to protect an area from construction activities and equipment; they will be removed after the work is complete.
 - Restoration, if needed, will take place when the project is complete.
- > **PROJECT COMPLETION:** We expect to complete the project and do final restoration of disturbed areas by the end of 2019.
