ACCEPTABLE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE MATERIALS:

From your workbench:

- Adhesives, Glues, resins
- Hobby supplies, artist supplies
- Oil Based paint
- Stains, thinners and strippers
- Solvents & varnishes

From your garage:

- Engine degreasers, brake fluids
- Transmission fluids
- Waste fuels (kerosene, gasoline)

From your yard:

- Insecticides, weed killers, poisons
- Pesticides
- Swimming pool chemicals
- Wood preservatives

From your house:

- Aerosol cans
- Mercury & articles with mercury
- Photo chemicals, chemistry sets
- Mercury added products



UNACCEPTABLE WASTE CLASSES:

- Asbestos
- Smoke Detectors
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Ammunition, fireworks, explosives
- Prescription medicines/syringes
- Commercial or industrial waste
- Infectious & biological waste
- Radioactive waste
- Fire extinguishers
- Tires
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Latex paint (pop top, let dry, throw away)
- Motor oil & car batteries

To ensure safety

- Never mix chemicals
- Never smoke while handling hazardous materials
- Do not place waste in garbage bags
- Tighten caps & lids leaving material in original labeled containers
- Sort and pack paint, pesticides & household cleaners separately
- Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes & pad with newspaper
- Pack your vehicle & go directly to the site
- Never dump these chemicals down the storm drain, your sink or toilet
- You must stay in your vehicle when at the drop off site
