

# CITIZEN OPTION MEETING VS. INFORMATIONAL BUDGET HEARING

## \*WHAT DETERMINES THE TYPE OF MEETING?

- The Citizen's Option Meeting is a time for registered voters to review the budget recommendations of the Select Board & Budget Committee.
- To declare the meeting a Citizen's Option Meeting, a minimum of 1% of the total number of registered voters must be officially checked in by the posted start time of the meeting and at all times during the meeting in order to make any motion or amendment to the budget recommendations presented. \*For the 2022 Citizens' Option Meeting 67 registered voters must be checked in by 6pm
- If the minimum assembly is not met by the posted start time of the meeting, the meeting shall be deemed an "Informational Budget Hearing".
