

- The Citizen's Option Meeting is a time for registered voters to review the budget recommendations of the Select Board & Budget Committee.
- To declare the meeting a Citizen's Option Meeting, a minimum of 1% of the total number of registered voters <u>must be officially checked in by the posted start time of the meeting</u> and at all times during the meeting in order to make any motion or amendment to the budget recommendations presented. *For the 2022 Citizens' Option Meeting 67 registered voters must be checked in by 6pm
- If the minimum assembly is not met by the posted start time of the meeting, the meeting shall be deemed an "Informational Budget Hearing".
