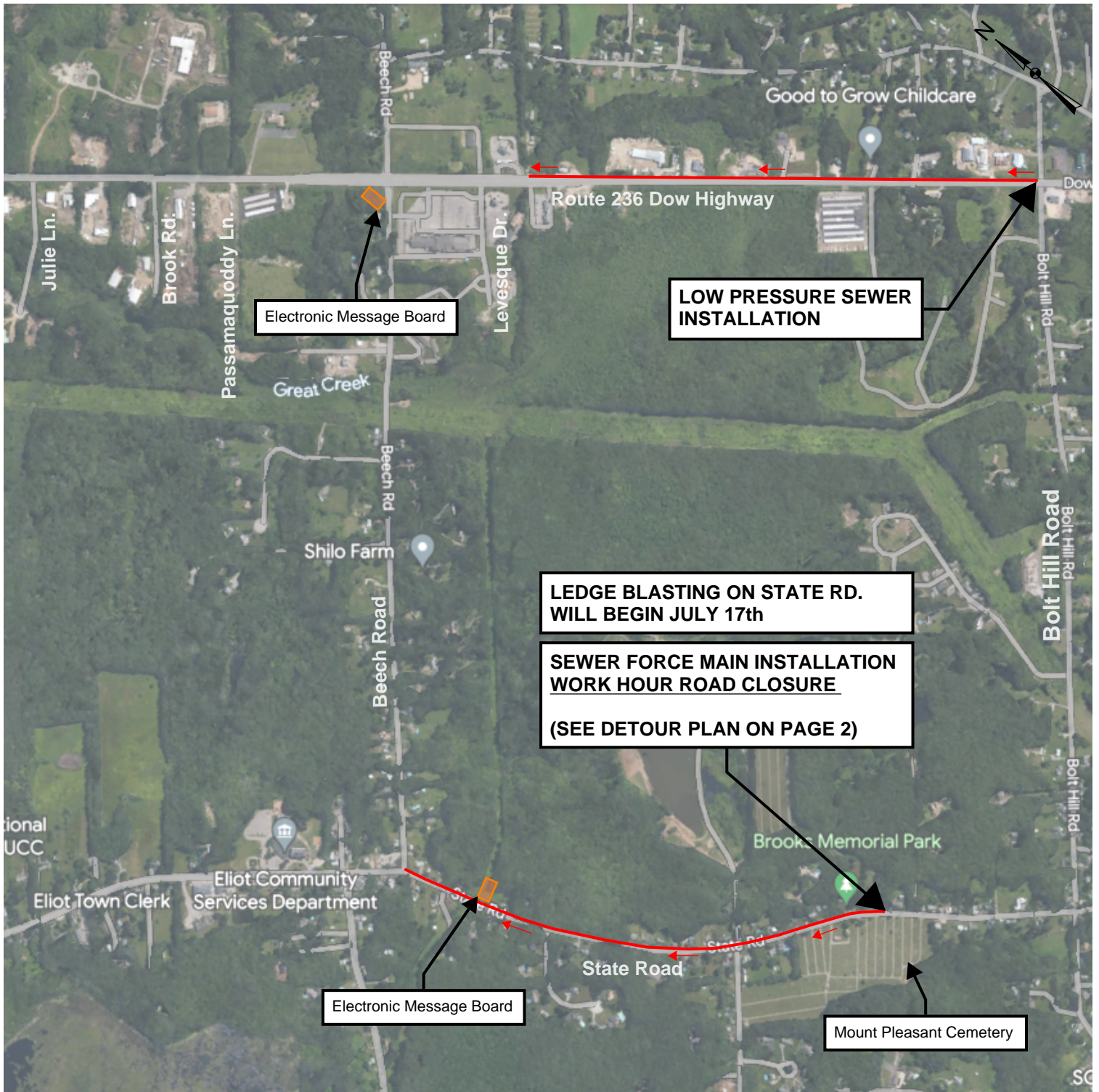


Route 236 TIF Area Sewer & Water Extension Bi-Weekly Progress Report July 3, 2023

 REPRESENTS THE ANTICIPATED WORK AREAS OVER THE NEXT 2 WEEKS.

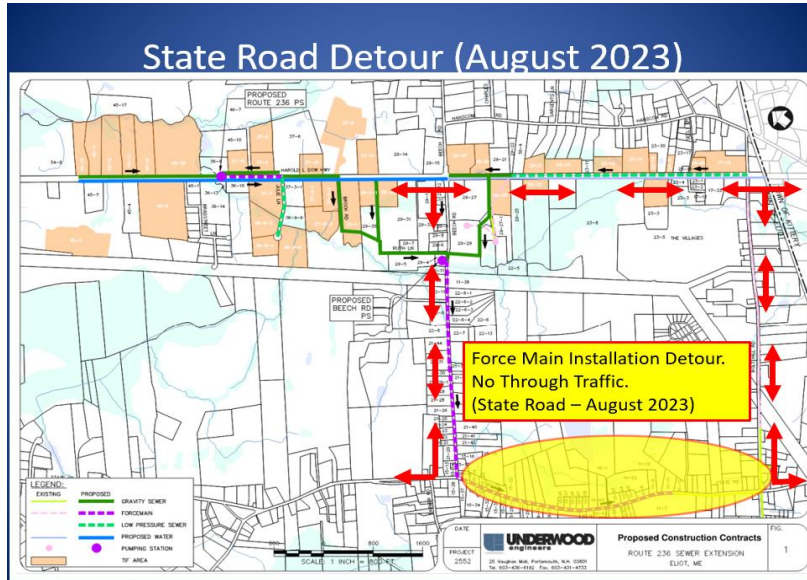


Route 236 TIF Area Sewer & Water Extension Bi-Weekly Progress Report July 3, 2023

This report identifies the work on the Route 236 Sewer Extension Project that DeFelice Corporation anticipates to be working on during the next two (2) weeks. We will make every effort to minimize disruption to your travel, but some travel delays should be expected navigating around the work zone. We would appreciate it if you would please use caution when driving through the construction zone to help ensure you and the street crews remain safe.

Next Two (2) Weeks

The following work is expected to take place along State Rd. and Route 236 (Harold Dow Highway) between Beech Rd. and Bolt Hill Rd. (See Page 1 showing the location and progress of the work).



- State Rd. will be closed to thru traffic during the regular work hours of 7AM – 5PM
- Thru traffic will be detoured around State Rd. using Bolt Hill Rd., Route 236, and Beech Rd.
- Normal traffic patterns will be restored at the end of each workday and over the weekend.
- Emergency personnel will be able to access State Road.

Weeks 7/3/23 through 7/14/23

- There will be no work July 3rd – July 4th
- Closure of State Rd. is planned through August 2023 for installation of sewer force main, beginning at Mount Pleasant Cemetery working toward Beech Rd.
- Ledge blasting on State Rd. will begin July 17th
- Installation of low-pressure sewer on the northbound side of route 236 beginning at Bolt Hill Rd. and working towards Levesque Dr.

Traffic Control

- For work along Route 236, two-way traffic will be delineated around the work zone.
- Normal traffic patterns will be restored at the end of each workday overnight until the following morning.
