- 81-acre preserve that borders a GWRLT farm easement and Eliot Town Forest land, creating a large block of conserved land
- Shorey Brook meanders through the property
- Connection to Eliot's **Johnson Lane Town Forest** is in progress
- 1.74 miles of trails
- Terrain: Moderate, mix of flat and hills

Directions: Located at 870 Goodwin Rd (Rte 101), Eliot; a small parking lot is available

DEAD DUCK (ELIOT BOAT BASIN)

- Trails accessible via boat launch parking lot
- Dog friendly
- Pavilion, field, bathroom facilities, beach, playground, and Piscataqua River access

Directions: 90 Hammond Lane, located off Main Street (Rte 103), near Green Acre Bahá'í School



ROCKY HILLS PRESERVE & PUNKINTOWN TOWN FOREST

- GWRLT Rocky Hills Preserve connects to York Pond and Bartlett Mill Pond through **Eliot Town Forest** (Punkintown area) and Maine IF&W lands
- 200-acre preserve with ~4 miles of trails
- Trails through a variety of habitats, including wetlands and forests
- Dog friendly
- Good for cross-country skiing in winter

Directions: Access trails off Punkintown Road in South Berwick, opposite Marshwood High School and behind Brixham Danceworks. GPS coordinates for parking: Lat: 43.198, Long: -70.790.



SAVAGE WILDLIFE PRESERVE

Great Works Regional Land Trust

- 26 acres on the Salmon Falls River, bordering Shorey's Brook
- 0.6 miles of flat trail
- Some of the best and most diverse habitat around, including a mix of woods, fields, and tidal and freshwater frontage
- No dogs allowed

Directions: Located on Rte 101 west of Rte 236, just over the South Berwick/Eliot town line, at 15 Dover-Eliot Road; parking available

DOUGLAS MEMORIAL WOODS

Great Works Regional Land Trust

Map: gwrlt.org/douglas-memorial-woods/

- 25 acres of woods and wetlands
- 0.8-mile trail
- Bridges allow passage in wet seasons
- Story Walk® that changes seasonally
- Dog friendly

Directions: Trailhead located at intersection of Old Road with State Road (Rte 103), near Fogg Memorial Library. John F. Hill Grange kindly allows parking for users of the trail at 1333 State Road.
