- 1) Reviewed and approved minutes for meeting held on September 15, 2015
- 2) Transfer station, Pay-to-throw, Kitchen food waste collection program
  - A. Transfer Station
    - Half of the new retaining wall plan has been installed.
    - Trucking 2 containers of MSW (trash) per month to Portland. It appears that residents that stopped using the transfer station after start of Pay-to-throw are coming back
    - Have completed 2 quarterly household hazardous waste (HHW) days going well conducting them on Wednesday is cheaper
  - B. Kitchen food waste Mr. Fox is picking up an average of 18 toters (96 gallons) per week. Assuming each toter weighs approximately 300 400 pounds, we are collecting about 164 tons per year of food waste, which would be about 1/3 of the town's combined MSW and food waste.

- Bud will contact the Fire Chief to see if we can use the fire station for educational session for residents on composting and a "trash on the lawn" demonstration showing how to improve recycling and reducing trash in the purple bags.
